

# Sea railing / lifeline - we got it

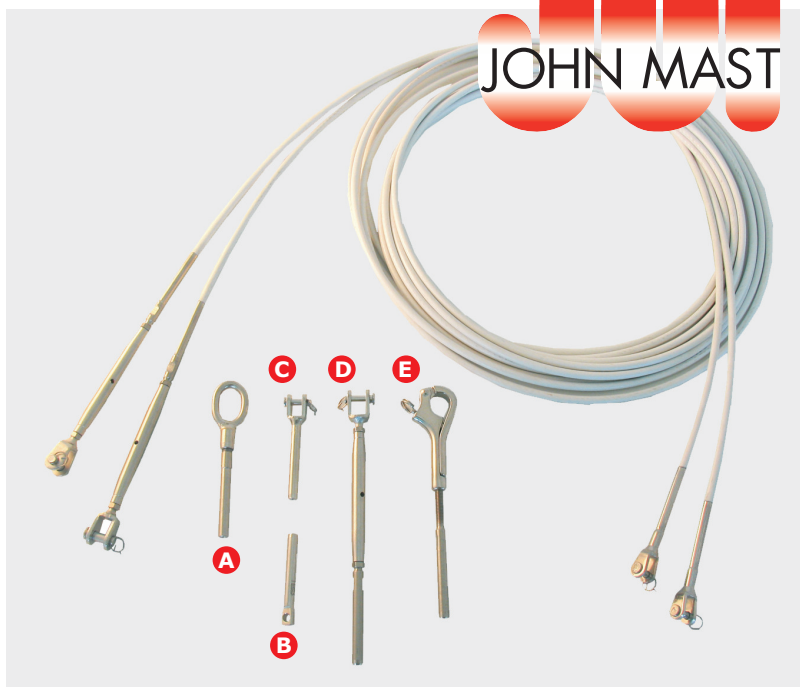


Mounting the sea railing shouldn't be a problem, nor replacing it. There is no doubt that the railing enhances the onboard security substantially. There is always something to hang onto when the boat heels and the children can be kept aboard while in harbor.

At John Mast's rigger shop, the rigger can make new sea railings or life lines as we call them, very fast provided that a length is given.

Mounting the stainless steel wire with end fittings only takes a few minutes. The wire is fixed at the aft pullpitt using a fork, key shackle, or snaplock making it a breeze to slack the wire then ever its needed in harbor or to access to bathing ladder.

To enhance the sitting comfort we can also deliver wire for mounting along the cockpit.



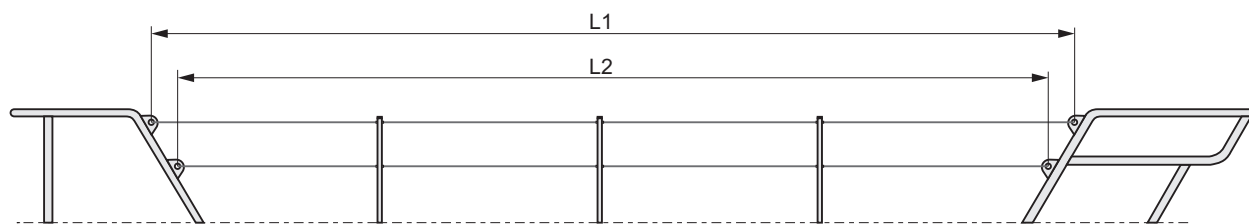

<b>A</b> Rolling eye	ø4 / ø5 / ø6
<b>B</b> Rolling eye	ø4
<b>C</b> Rolling fork	ø4 / ø6
<b>D</b> Rolling fork with spanner	ø4, ø6
<b>E</b> Rolling terminal with snaplock	ø4

**All dimensions are in millimetres**



When measuring the lengths its important not to measure directly from pullpitt to pullpitt. All measures are taken via the sceptre's
